


### Which resea determine v

• Encourage Waste Segregation – Promote household and school-based recycling programs to reduce waste mismanagement.


 Advocate for Policy Changes – Work with local authorities to push for better wages, safety gear, and improved working conditions for laborers.


#### Influencing our schoolteacher community
