#### How is this a real world problem or concern?

Yes, wasting food and burning dry leaves are real world problems. Below statistics and studies can prove our statement

- 1.3 billion tons of food is getting wasted while 7,745.7 and 19,701.7 people dying daily as a result of acute hunger, and between 5.39 and 13.69 people dying per minute.
- People are consuming higher levels of pesticides, antibiotics, hormones in the form of inorganic food
- Burining dry leaves cause air pollution which lead to global warming.
- Smoke from the dry leaves causes serious health problems





If the Food is not in a stage to eat, then we will definitely use it in Compost pit





Since Burning Leaves is not good for environment we will request our school management and villagers instead of burning them allow them to decompose or use it compost pits




